

AIRPORT - Please print this section!!!

You will be flying into Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, Kenya. The airport is about 20 minutes from the SIM Rose Avenue Compound. The following is a step-by-step guide to making it through the airport. It would be good if you were to print this section and carry it with you in your hand luggage.

1. You will need US\$50 to obtain a visa if you do not already have one stamped in your passport. Make sure the bills were printed after 2000.
2. You will be in the country for (length of stay), as stated in your round trip ticket.
3. Your purpose is to visit friends, their churches and a game park.
4. Your address while in Kenya is Rose Ave of Ngong Road
5. A phone number is 020-272-4622
6. BEFORE getting your luggage, please come to the glass divider and look for someone (usually Daniel) holding an SIM sign and wave to indicate that you have arrived. We try to be right across from the door.
7. AFTER you get your luggage, go through the customs line, which reads either NO CLAIMS or NOTHING TO CLAIM. When asked what is in your luggage, simply indicate that it is clothes and personal items, all of which you will be needing during your stay and taking back with you. If you want to prepare a packing list ahead of time, that is fine, but is usually only necessary for boxes, not suitcases.
8. In case your luggage does not arrive on the same plane as you do, you will need to fill out a form. They will deliver it free of charge, usually within the next day or so. You can ask for some monetary compensation, but they don't always give it. They certainly won't give it if you don't ask!
 - a. Address: Rose Ave off Ngong Road, near the City Mortuary
 - b. Directions: Ngong Rd towards Karen, past Nairobi Baptist Church and Coptic Hospital. Rose Ave is first right after Coptic. After 3rd speed bump, take a right onto Rose Lane. First gate on right. Plot number 209/390/5.
